Transportation

Transport is provided by coach to and from the AFM (St Kilda).

Departure time: 4.30pm on Friday 26 May 2017 at 51 Grey Street St Kilda. *Please ensure that you arrive at the AFM by 4.00pm on the day of departure.*

Return time: Approximately 4.00pm on Sunday 28 May 2017.

Registration fee

Full fee: \$408 all inclusive.

The Languages Unit of DET will provide a full subsidy of \$408 for up to 20 students from government schools to participate in the camp. Applications for the subsidy must be submitted by 05 May 2017.

Students will be advised by 10 May 2017 whether they have been accepted to participate and whether they will receive a \$408 subsidy from the DET.

Conditions

Any student who accepts a subsidy commits to attend the event.
